(1) During their second MAIS year, students have to pass the core modules E (4 ECTS) and F (Master Thesis and Master thesis seminar; 22 ECTS) and the thesis defence (2 ECTS).

During the entire 2-year programme, students have to fulfil the following requirements:

(2) They have to pass courses worth at least 44 ECTS from the advanced modules G to J. Students who were granted a waiver (part or total) in the Core modules A to D have to acquire a corresponding number of additional ECTS points in the modules G to J.

This implies that at least 100 ECTS points (or 102 ECTS, if you include the thesis defence) have to be earned in the modules A to J.

- (3) Courses have to be chosen from at least three of the four modules G to J.
- (4) Courses must include at least 3 seminars.
- (5) At least 4 ECTS points have to be earned within the language module in French or German (module M).
- (6) Overall, courses amounting to a minimum of 120 ECTS have to be successfully completed. ECTS points missing after fulfilling all degree requirements (1) to (5) can be acquired by passing courses from modules G to M.

Students who have been admitted directly to the second MAIS year have to fulfil the following requirements:

- (1) Students have to pass the core modules E (4 ECTS) and F (Master Thesis and Master thesis seminar; 22 ECTS) and the thesis defence (2 ECTS).
- (2) Students have to pass courses worth at least 28 ECTS from the optional modules G to J, including at least two seminars. Courses have to be chosen from at least three of the four modules. With the permission of the Dean, courses from the Core modules A to D can also count towards this requirement.
- (3) Overall, courses amounting to a minimum of 60 ECTS have to be successfully completed. ECTS points missing after fulfilling all degree requirements (1) to (2) can be acquired by passing courses from modules G to M.

NB. Please note that some US universities will not accept credits earned by language courses in the academic records as a basis for further studies at their institutions.
