

Irmgard Marboe

Dr Irmgard Marboe is Associate Professor of International Law at the Institute of European Law, International and Comparative Law, Department of International Law and International Relations, at the Faculty of Law of the University of Vienna. One of her research focuses is the relationship between Islamic law and international law with a particular focus on human rights and the rule of law. She was co-rapporteur of the ILA Committee "Islamic Law and International Law" and co-authored, together with Hossein Esmaeili and Javid Rehman, the book *The Rule of Law, Freedom of Expression and Islamic Law* (Hart Publishing, 2017). Since 2008 she has been the director of the Vienna International Christian-Islamic Summer University organised by the University of Vienna at the Abbey of Altenburg (Lower Austria). Other research focuses include international investment law and the law of outer space. She is the author of *Calculation of Compensation and Damages in International Investment Law* (Oxford University Press, 2009 and 2017) and numerous other publications on international investment law. She is the head of the Austrian National Point of Contact (NPOC) for Space Law of the European Centre for Space Law, a regular member of the Austrian delegation to the UN Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space, and Vice-Chair of the Austrian Research Promotion Agency's Advisory Board on Air- and Spaceflight. In 2014/2015 and in 2016, she was a visiting scholar at Stanford University (CA, USA).
