He is the author of *Co-managing International Crises* (Cambridge University Press 2019), *Irredentism in European Politics* (Cambridge University Press, 2008), co-author of *Understanding International Diplomacy* (Routledge, 2013 and 2018), and co-editor of *Arguing Global Governance* (Routledge, 2010), *Metaphors of Globalization* (Palgrave, 2007), *Communication, Legitimation and Morality in Modern Politics* (Routledge, 2018), and *Diplomacy and Borderlands: African Agency at the Intersections of Orders* (Routledge, 2020).
